1986 (Act No. 9 of 1986), the Government of Goa hereby make the following rules so as to further amend the Goa State Fire Force Rules, 1997 as follows:—

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 35 of the Goa, Daman and Diu, Fire Force Act,

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (i) These rules may be called the Goa State Fire Force (Third Amendment) Rules, 2004.

(ii) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of APPENDIX-IV.*— In APPENDIX- IV appended to the Goa State Fire Force Rules, 1997 and as amended from time to time for the existing entries at Sr. No. (1) to (12) the following entries shall be substituted, namely:—
